**The Committee shall have another meeting which is expected to be taken place in September with important activities:**

- **Developing an Implementation matrix**
- **Documenting the Strategic Plan**
- **Developing system to monitor and evaluate the implementation.**

# ***Work Plan in 2013***

**Reviewing the progress of the other three committees and incorporated the needed changes to the strategic plan to ensure the up- to- date and reliability criteria of this important document and be ready for the approval by the 2<sup>nd</sup> ASEANSAI Assembly in Brunei at the end of 2013 and the Strategic Plan will be implemented from 2014 until 2017**
